Position:

Part time Chaplain for Lighthouse wards and Duchess Leisia units. (3 and a half hours a week) The patients on these wards, for the main part are elderly, frail and many have dementia.

JOB SUMMARY

The post holder will offer pastoral support to patients, their relatives and staff as required. The post holder will work as a member of the Chaplaincy and the multidisciplinary team as part of the overall holistic care. It will be a trainee post and it will be remunerated. This post is open to ordained and lay ministers.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- To provide pastoral and spiritual care to patients, relatives and staff in these areas.
- To advise staff in identifying the spiritual needs of patients and their families.
- To lead services for patients, families, staff as required.
- To participate in meetings of the Chaplaincy team.
- To participate in the out of hours on-call arrangements for the Chaplaincy Team. (Including the MIP)
- To work collaboratively with colleagues in the Chaplaincy team and the wider faith communities.
- To undertake ongoing training where appropriate.
- To support staff of all faiths or none.
- To play a role in the provision of end of life and bereavement care as necessary.
- To receive and participate in regular supervision.

GENERAL

- To be aware of the philosophy of the Chaplaincy team and to behave as a fit representative.
- To be aware of all relevant policies and procedures of HSC.
- To attend statutory training courses as required.
- To keep good records of Chaplaincy work undertaken.
- To respect the confidentiality of anyone who confides in them.
